

Cat Facts

Two uncontrolled breeding cats create at least 2 litters per year with a survival rate of 2-3 kittens per litter. This breeding pair and its offspring will, in one year, create 12 cats. This may not sound like much, but in the second year, 12 cats will become 66. In the third year, 66 cats will become 2,201. This cycle will continue and in the tenth year, those first 2 breeding cats will be responsible for the creation of 803,099 new cats.
